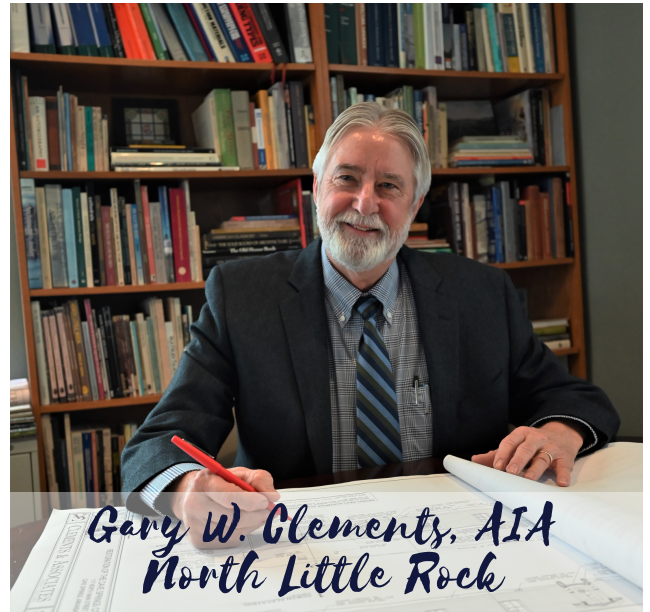

2021 PARKER WESTBROOK AWARD FOR LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT



A lifelong history enthusiast, Gary Clements has been an ardent supporter of historic preservation since 1981, when he graduated from the University of Arkansas School of Architecture. Clements started working on preservation projects at the Arkansas State Capitol in 1985, when he was on the staff of Burt Taggart and Associates, and this work at the Capitol building and its grounds continued through the establishment of his own firm, Clements and Associates, in 1997. There are only a few spaces in the building, from the dome to the basement, where Clements has not worked. In addition to his notable work at the State Capitol, Clements has completed restoration and rehabilitation projects throughout Arkansas and served on numerous preservation-related boards and commissions. Clements was a pioneer in the restoration of his neighborhood, the Argenta Historic District, working with the Argenta CDC to rehabilitate 55 living units in the mid-1990s. For his 40 years of dedication to the preservation of Arkansas's built environment, Preserve Arkansas is pleased to recognize Gary Clements with the 2021 Parker Westbrook Award for Lifetime Achievement!
